Funding from the NRCS and the RRWCD is paid 1/5 per year in 5 years			

**CRITERIA**

- \* **Must be Permanent Well Retirement**
- \* South Fork Focus Area: All wells **inside** the area as describe by the attached map.
- \* Outside SF Focus Area: All wells within the RRWCD boundary that are **outside** the South Fork Focus Area.
- \* Applications for the 2020 funding begins at the NRCS offices.
- \* Acres must have been certified irrigated 2 out of the last 5 years just prior to enrollment.
- \* Water Permit, County Assessor's records, FSA 578's will be evaluated by the RRWCD as part of the application process.
- \* Applications that are successful in the ranking process of NRCS, and meet their requirements will then be eligible for RRWCD funding.
- \* RRWCD contracts will require deed and lien holder information.
- \* Upon signing a contract with the NRCS for EQIP funding, the producer has 30 days in which to sign a contract with the RRWCD in order to qualify for the RRWCD funding.
- \* Criteria is not limited to the above mentioned items and all are **subject to change**.
