

**RESOLUTION OF THE REPUBLICAN RIVER

*(To Change the Posting Place for Official Notice to the District's official website and
to Comply with HB 19-1087)*

RESOLUTION NO. 21-14

R E C I T A L S

WHEREAS, the Republican River Water Conservation District ("District") was created pursuant to section 37-50-103(1), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the District is managed and controlled by its Board of Directors ("Board");
and

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly duly enacted House Bill 19-1087 and said Bill was signed into law by the Governor of Colorado on April 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 19-1087 is now in effect; and

WHEREAS, section II(A) of House Bill 19-1087 states:

It is the intent of the General Assembly that local governments transition from posting physical notices of public meetings in physical locations to posting notices on a website, social media account, or other official online presence of the local government to the greatest extent practicable;

and,

WHEREAS, section III of House Bill 19-1087 states, in part:

A local public body that posts notices of public meetings on a public website pursuant to this subsection (2)(c)(III) shall designate a public place within the boundaries of the local public body at which it may post a notice no less than twenty-four hours prior to a meeting if it is unable to post a notice online in exigent or emergency circumstances such as a power outage or an interruption in internet service that prevents the public from accessing the notice online.

RESOLUTION


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of the District that:


1. The official posting places for required posting of notices, agendas and other required information will be on the District's official website, under an appropriate tab at the landing page: www.republicanriver.com.
2. The alternate posting place to be used in exigent or other circumstances where the public is not able to access the District's official website will be: the front window of the District's office, facing Main St., Wray, Colorado.
