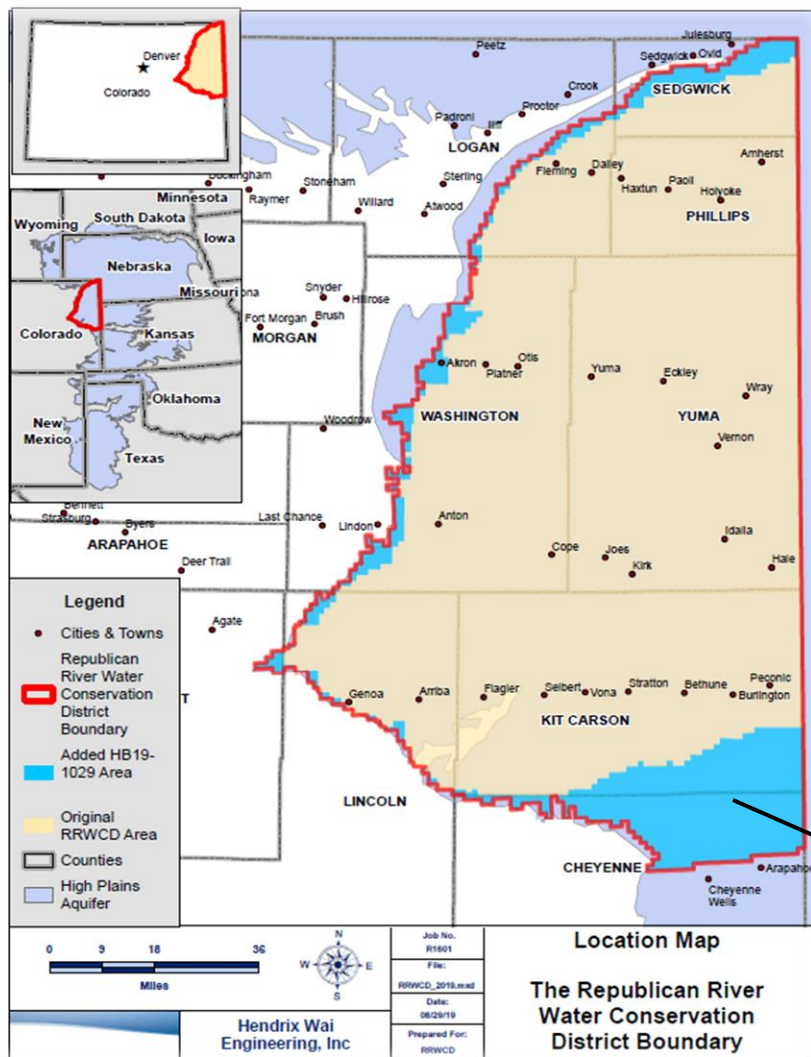


Do you own irrigated land in the Republican River Water Conservation District?



In 2004, the Colorado legislature created the RRWCD using the topographical boundary.

House Bill 19-1029, (HB19-1029) was approved during the 2019 legislative session. HB 19-1029 corrected the RRWCD boundary to match the Republican River domain set in 2002.

All irrigated acres in the RRWCD boundary will be assessed a water use fee that will be collected in 2020 with the tax-roll.

During the August quarterly Board meeting, the RRWCD approved the following pro-rated assessment fee on all acres irrigated in 2019 that were brought into the District by HB19-1029

- \$6.00/irrigated acre

Starting in 2020 all irrigated acres will be assessed the same fee (\$14.50) in the tax-roll of each county in the RRWCD.

To verify the number of your irrigated acres and if they are located inside the RRWCD boundary, contact the RRWCD or your County Assessor.
