RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Republican River Water Conservation District (“District”) was created pursuant to section 37-50-103(1), C.R.S., and pursuant to section 37-50-103(1), C.R.S., is a body corporate under the laws of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the District was formed for the purpose of cooperating with and assisting the State of Colorado to carry out its duty to comply with the limitations and duties imposed upon the State by the Republican River Compact; and

WHEREAS, the District continues to seek partners and funding sources to continue its efforts to assist the State of Colorado to carry out its duty to comply with the limitations and duties imposed upon the State by the Republican River Compact; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation has established and funded a program known as WaterSmart (Sustain and Manage America’s Resources for Tomorrow); and

WHEREAS, District staff, acting with the knowledge and support of the Board of Directors of the District has filed an application for a grant of \$100,000 through the WaterSmart program.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board, as follows:

The Board of Directors of the Republican River Water Conservation District hereby formally affirms its approval of the application for a grant of \$100,000 (Application for Federal Assistance SF-424) filed by the District’s General Manager, Debra Daniel and dated January 15, 2021.
